The COVID-19 pandemic has had a major impact on education, disrupting traditional delivery methods and forcing institutions to adapt technology and rethink ways of curriculum delivery especially so for dentistry which thus far has been a course conducted with direct close supervision. A substantial portion of the Community Oral Health curriculum which involves interaction with the community and organising oral health promotion events for the public was also affected. Some of the longstanding methods in teaching and learning had to be temporarily abandoned and looking for alternative online activities with similar learning outcomes can indeed be challenging.
